Eligibility

The nominee must:

- be a PMI Member in good standing (current dues are paid)
- under the age of 35 at the time the application is due
- have made significant positive impact to the outcome of a project, through leadership, technical
 project management and strategic and business management, in the past 36 months from the
 nomination deadline (March 25, 2024)
- be nominated by at least two (2) individuals, one of whom must be the following:
 - o nominee's manager
 - o a project team member
 - o an end user/customer
- The award recognizes the PM's capability and contributions to the project as the primary criterion.
- have demonstrated mastery of PM, evidenced by a PMI certification (e.g. CAPM, PMP, PgMP etc.)

Not Eligible

- Self-nomination is not permitted.
- Current board members of the PMI Rochester Chapter and award committee members are not eligible.
- Individuals or organizations that have failed to comply with PMI policies and procedures, including but not limited to PMI's Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct, will not be considered.
